RIVERSIDE CITY COUNCIL MEETING: April 16, 2018

The Riverside City Council meeting opened at 6:30 pm in City Hall with Mayor Allen Schneider requesting roll call. Council members present were: Rob Weber, Jeanine Redlinger, Andy Rodgers, Tom Sexton, and Bob Schneider Jr.

Motion by Sexton to approve the agenda, Second by Rodgers, passed 5-0.

Sexton moved to approve the minutes from April 2nd, and the expenditures. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

Bill Poch addressed Council on ditch drainage problems at the corner of 1^{st} and Boise Street. MMS will look at intersection and give options on repairs.

Redlinger moved to allow Highland students to perform "Earth Day" clean – up in our city parks. Second by Weber, passed 5-0.

Chris Kirkwood informed Council about bad spots on Schnoebelen Street. Lenz will have LL Pelling check into repair options and costs.

Bill Poch will organize a citizen's committee for a Dog Park, and report back in May.

Council accepted Riverside Fire Report for March.

Ragbrai Chairman, Kevin Meller updated Council on the meeting held in Ames. They have set a Town Meeting for Sunday, April 22 in St. Mary's Hall at 2:30 PM for everyone interested in helping with Ragbrai when they pass through Riverside on July 27, 2018.

Weber moved to approve \$12,000 for entertainment budget. Second by Rodgers, passed 4-1 Redlinger opposed.

MMS Consultant, Ben Mitchell reported on progress on the Downtown Streetscape. Lead water supply lines were found going into buildings. State Code requires that City replace lines.

Sexton moved to approve Resolution 0416018-06; Pay Request #1 for Downtown Streetscape to J&L Construction for \$130,043.60. Second by Weber, passed 5-0.

Galileo Street Bid letting was held on April 11th. Bid tabulation was presented to Council.

Sexton moved to pass Resolution 041618-01; Awarding Construction Contract to Triple B Construction Corp. in the amount of \$476,685.50 for the Galileo Drive Street project. Second by Schneider, passed 5-0.

TUMC members were not in attendance to discuss parking issues. Council agreed to have a written request form filled out, before items are placed on the agenda.

Rodgers moved to pass Resolution 041618-02; Approving Easement for City Welcome Sign with Corrine and Dennis Walker at \$300 a year for 20 years. Second by Sexton, passed 5-0.

Rodgers moved to pass Resolution 041618-10; Setting the Date for Public Hearing for Property Tax Rebate Agreement with Terry Stumpf for "Ice It LLC" on May, 7th at the 6:30 pm Council meeting. Second by Weber, passed 5-0.

Weber moved to pass Resolution 041618-04; Lease Riverside Community Building to John Sojka. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

Redlinger moved to accept the 2018 Urban Renewal Action and Commercial Development Agreement with Dorsey & Whitney LLP not to exceed \$8,500. Second by Weber, passed 5-0.

Redlinger moved to pass Resolution 041618-05; Setting the date for Public Hearing on Designation of the Expanded Riverside Urban Renewal Area, and on Urban Renewal Plan Amendment on May, 7th at the 6:30 pm Council meeting. Second by Rodgers, passed 5-0.

Weber moved to pass Resolution 041618-07; Approving Iowa State Extention Summer Youth Camps with a cost not to exceed \$600. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

Schneider moved to pass Resolution 041618-08; Awarding the Waste Water Plant Parking Lot Re-surfacing Project to Stransky Concrete at a cost of \$37,446. Second by Weber, passed 5-0.

Weber moved to pass Resolution 041618-09; Approving Street Maintenance Cost estimate from LL Pelling in the amount of \$38,232.95. Second by Redlinger, passed 4-1 Sexton opposed.

Schneider moved to schedule the Iowa State Auditor's Office to perform the annual exam for FY2018. Second by Weber, passed 5-0. Contract and cost estimate to follow.

Sexton moved to approve, and post the Deputy City Clerk job description. Second by Weber, passed 5-0.

Bill Stukey, PeopleService, Inc. presented the March water and waste water report.

Mayor Schneider set Monday, April 23, 2018 for a special meeting to work on Northern Development, and the Hwy 22 Street project.

Weber moved to adjourn at 9:15 pm. Second by Rodgers, passed 5-0.
