

COUNCIL PACKET

RIVERSIDE CITY COUNCIL MEETING: Monday, November 1, 2021

The Riverside City Council met on Monday, November 1, 2021, at the Riverside City Council Chambers. Mayor Allen Schneider called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and following the Pledge of Allegiance request roll call. Council members present: Tom Sexton, Edgar McGuire, Andy Rodgers, Lois Schneider, and Kevin Mills.

Motion made by McGuire to approve agenda, second by Sexton. Motion passed 5-0.

After discussion on the Fire Department equipment to be sold Motion made by McGuire to approve Consent Agenda, including 10-18-21 minutes, 11-1-21 expenditures, and selling of FD equipment, second by Sexton. Motion passed 5-0.

After discussion on number of gallons to fill pool, motion made by McGuire to approve \$80.40 partial sewer abatement, second by Mills. Motion carried 5-0.

Brian Boelk-Axiom, reviewed final designs, cost estimates and timetable to Railroad Park Project.

Steve Smith from Johnson County Refuse addressed council on his decision to sell his company and talked about an assignment form. Contract going forward will include city wide clean up twice a year and remove the stick pickup. Motion made Sexton, second by McGuire to amend contract as discussed. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion made by Sexton to set Public Hearing for Plans and Specification and Notice to Bid for Railroad Project for November 15, 2021, at 6:00 p.m. in the council chambers. Second by Schneider. Roll call. All yes, motion carried 5-0.

Further discussion was held on the City Administrator's amended contract prepared by the city attorney. Mayor Schneider gave an overview of the redline items that had changed to the final amended contract for approval. Motion made by McGuire to approve amended contract, second by Sexton. Roll call vote. Rodgers, Sexton, McGuire aye, Schneider, Mills nay. Motion carried 3-2.

City Administrator Yancey read report to mayor, council, and reviewed citizen request to discuss street parking during snow removal at a later date. Mayor Schneider and Council member Schneider will be on the Community Visioning Committee. Yancey gave overview of discussion with Sheriff Schneider on upcoming meeting concerning accidents and issues on Hwy 22. Motion made by Sexton to fill ex-officio vacancy on Riverboat Foundation Board for one year with council member McGuire, second by Schneider. Motion passed 5-0.

Motion made by McGuire, second by Mills to accept resignation of Rodgers from council as he is moving out of the city. Motion passed 4-0.

Motion made by Sexton to adjourn meeting, second by McGuire. Motion carried 4-0. Mayor adjourned the meeting the time being 7:31 p.m.

Training:

The members trained on vertical ventilation, roof operations, ladders, saws, forcible entry and fire behavior. This training was done at the RFD burn building under live fire conditions.

RESA:

The members finalized plans for the fall raffle dinner to be held at the VFW. The raffle dinner is on November 6th at 5pm.

Other News

The members had another steady month with calls, we once again had some very challenging calls involving motor vehicle accidents. These types of incidents are often tough on our members and their mental health. We as a department work with our members to provide them help with outside agencies that deal in critical incident stress. The members did a school visit with Ainsworth FD to the Highland Elementary for fire prevention week. We also participated in Trunk or Treat at the school. The department provided Fire and EMS standby for the demo derby, I will provide more on the safety issues with this event at our work session. The annual service testing was done on the ladder truck by UL laboratories and Testing. This is an annual test and inspection of the aerial ladder and all ground ladders that must be done to be NFPA compliant. The members also work with the City guys to burn the brush pile out at the maintenance building.

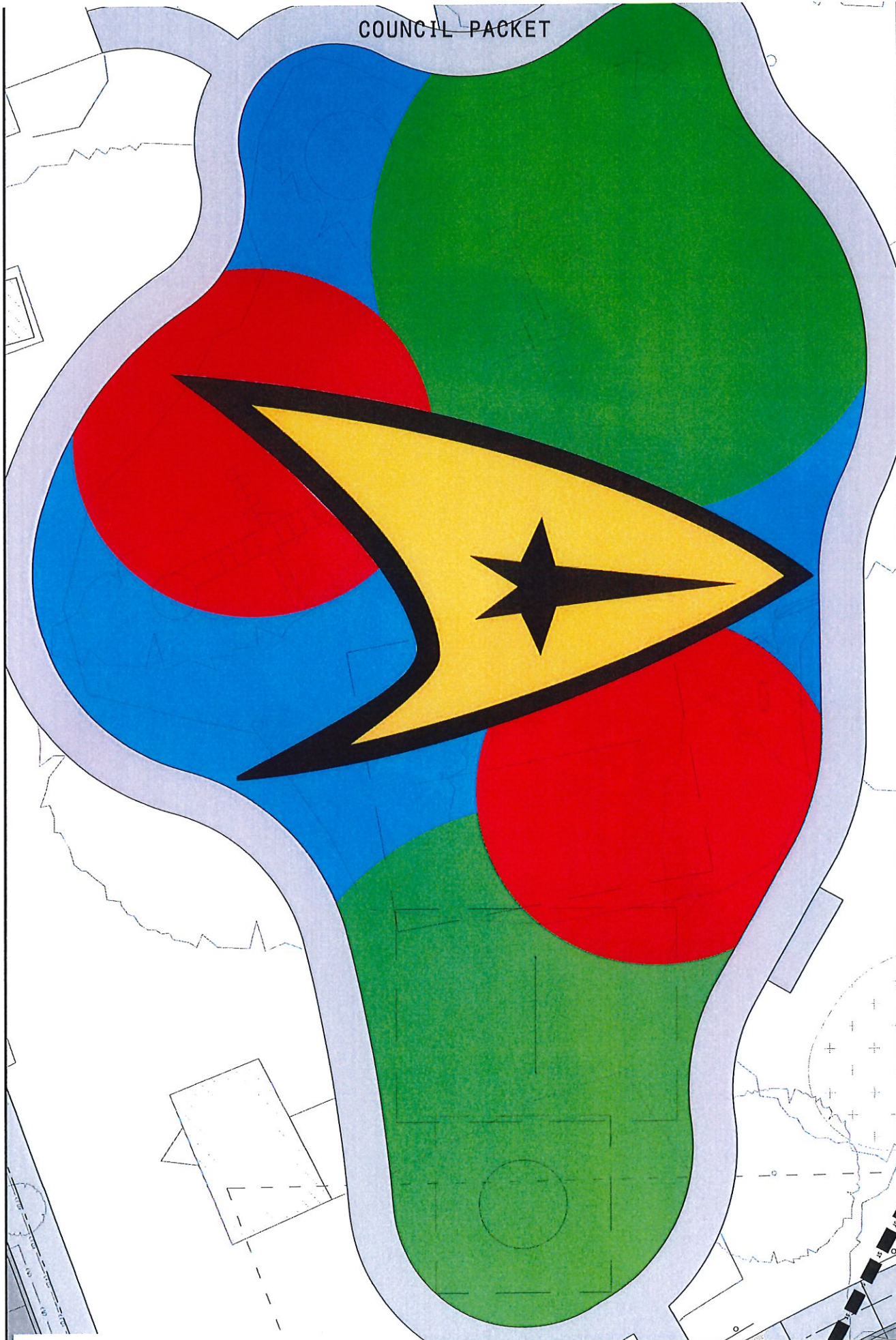

O & M Report: October 2021

Water Operation & Maintenance

- I was called by Omnisite on 10-10-21 for train 2 at the water plant failing to run. When I arrived the train had shut down for a pump failure. During inspection I didn't immediately find anything wrong that would have caused the pump to fail. I shut down power to the train and opened the inspection cover for the wires going to the pump. I found a wire nut for one of the lead wires had worn through the plastic and grounded the wire. This caused the pump to shut down. I cut back about an inch of fresh wire and reconnected the wires, while applying some friction tape to help prevent this from happening again. The fix took about twenty minutes and was able to get the train back online.
- We completed our fall hydrant flushing. We plan to schedule hydrant painting for next year where we will go and paint all the hydrants that are in need.
- On 10-28-21 around 3:40 PM I received an alarm for the RO shutting down unexpectedly. On arrival I noticed water on the floor. I found two broken 8" 90 degree elbows. We had some premade and ready to install. Ben and I worked for about two hours and had both installed. I went to start the plant when a large section of pipe and fittings going to cartridge filters 2 and 3 broke and fell about 10 feet from the air. We did not have all the parts to make the repairs that night and there was about 11 feet of water in the clear well. The next day on Friday we had sourced the few parts we didn't already have on hand from Brown's Supply in Cedar Rapids. Ben went to get the parts while I started making the repairs. By 1 PM we had made the repairs to this section of line and went to start the plant. Immediately we had two more 8" T fittings, two 10" 45 degree fittings and a 1" chemical feed line break. We had the parts to fix most of these on hand.



We were able to make all the repairs we could, minus the 10" parts. The 10" parts are cracked and leaking but were restrained to where they wouldn't completely break and would allow us to fill the tank. Friday's repairs took around 12 hours to complete. The plant ran all night and I checked on it though out the night and next day. While doing rounds on Sunday I assessed and further damage that may have incurred. I found a T fitting that reduces to 3" may have been compromised from the stress. There is no thrust block or restraint on this line. I used a ratchet strap to help restrain the line if it were to break and keep from breaking more fittings. On Monday I started the plant again and the 3" line I was concerned about broke, fortunately the ratchet strap performed as I expected and prevented it from flexing too much and breaking more pipe. I had Schimberg deliver a reducer bushing so we could make the repair. We let that fitting cure overnight and started the plant again on Tuesday. The plant ran all day Tuesday without issue, except for the 10" parts we were still waiting for. These fittings are not breaking from pressure, but stress. The raw water line only has around 40 psi while running, but the lack of thrust blocks and hangers stresses the lines as the well turns on and causes them to flex, which weakens them over time. Schedule 80 pipe is not a very common material for water plant process piping and can be difficult to obtain, often requiring special ordering.

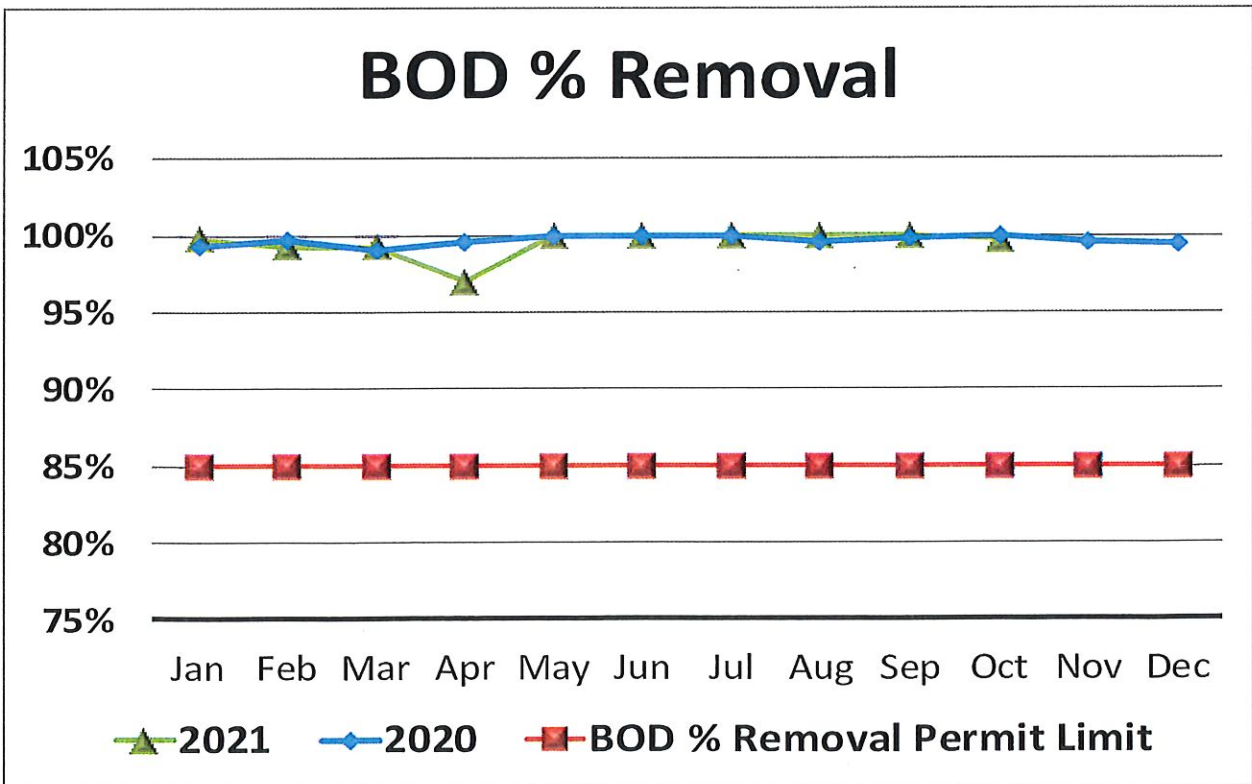
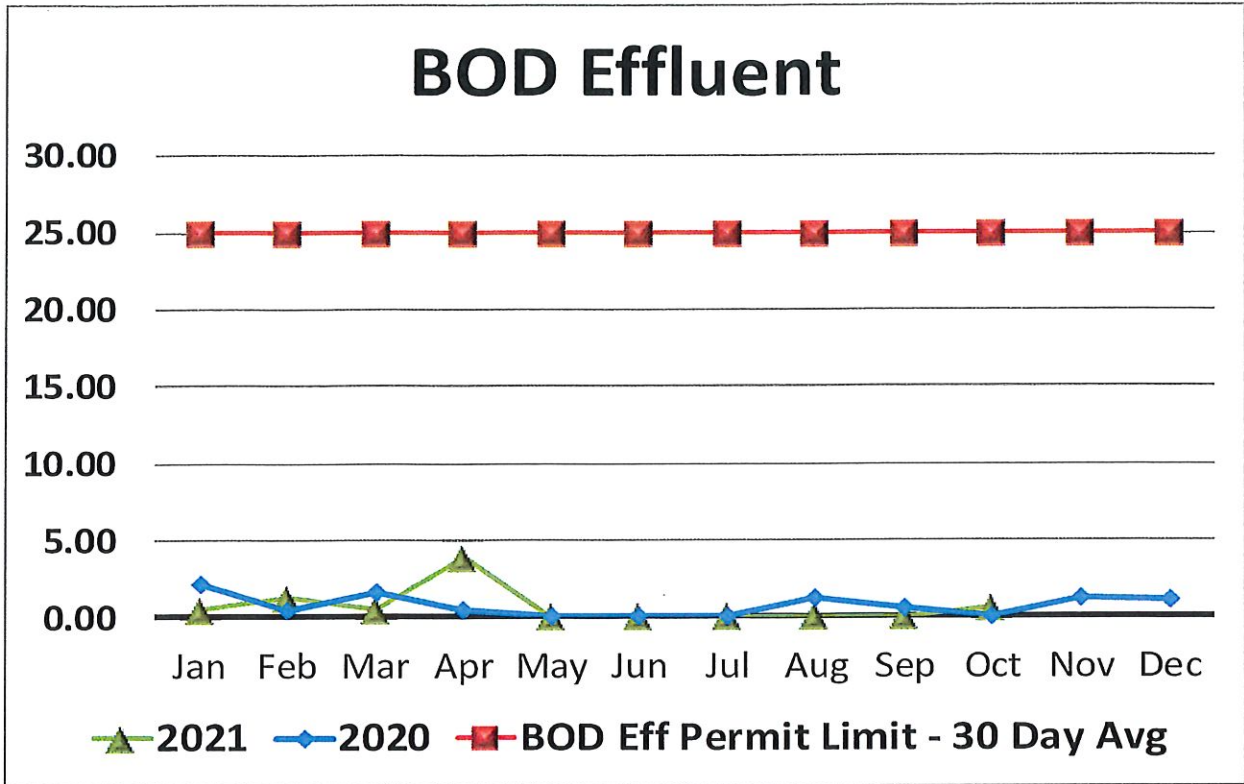
- We replaced batteries in generators at lift stations 1, 2, 3 and 5. We will replace batteries in the other units next year.
- The heater hoses for the block heater on the wastewater plant generator were starting to crack. I had new hoses made and replaced them.
- We removed several small trees that were growing up the hill on the north side of the wastewater plant.

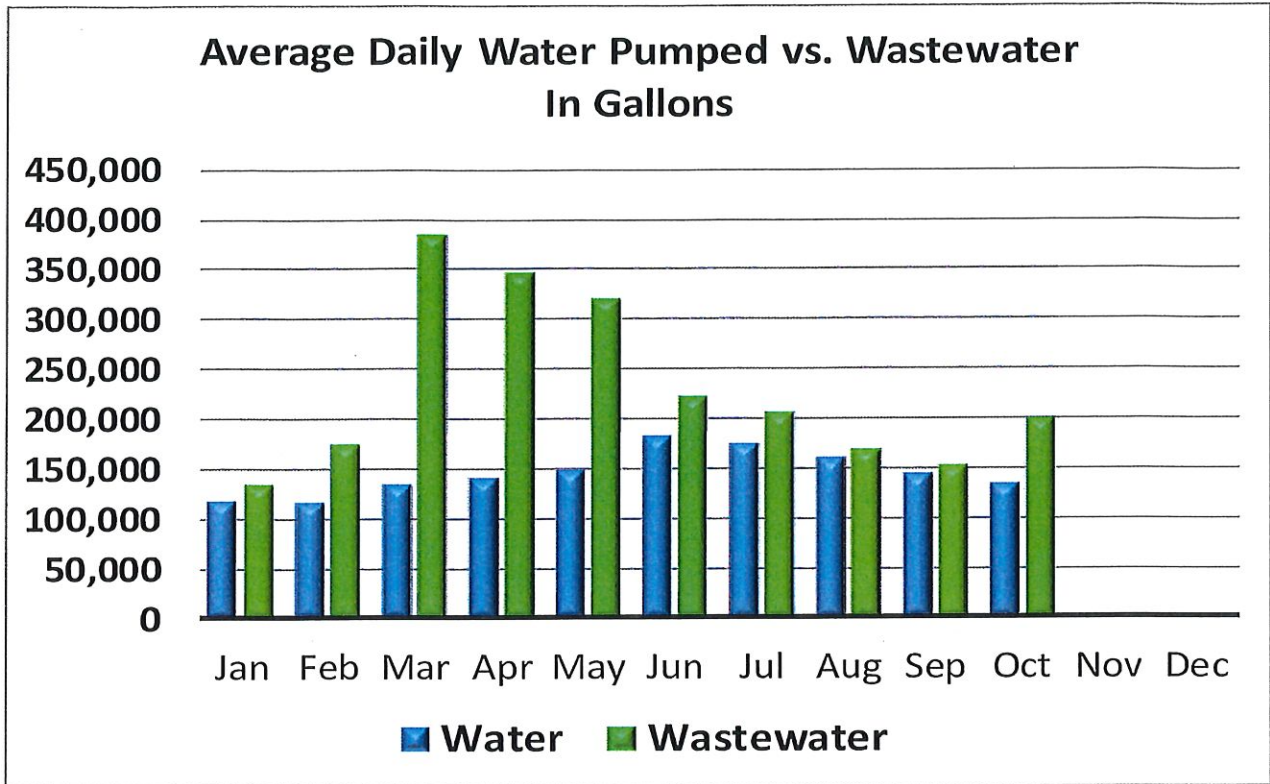


- We serviced both portable generators and the trash pump with fresh oil and gas. All units were run and in great condition. One generator had a small gas leak and we installed a new petcock.
- Blower 1 at the wastewater plant was failing to run. During inspection I found the same issue as the pump at the water plant for train 2. These wires use a large metal lug to connect the leads together and are taped. The vibration of the motor running caused the tape to rub against the case and wear through, grounding the leads. I used the same approach as the other pump and retaped then wrapped in friction tape which is stronger and harder to wear through.

Jeanine Redlinger resigned her council position in June, 2021. Kevin Mills was appointed June 21, 2021 to fill the vacancy through 12/31/2021 after the ten day posting of the intention to fill the vacancy.

Andy Rodgers resigned his council position at the end of the meeting November 1, 2021. His term would have ended December 31, 2021.

COUNCIL PACKET

At the last election, Kevin Mills was elected for the four year term vacated by Andy Rodgers. Kevin Kiene was elected to fill the remaining two years of Jeanine Redlinger's term. When we talked today, you indicated Kevin Kiene would now be sworn in and fill the last six weeks of 2021, and then fulfill the last two years of Jeanine Redlinger's term, replacing Kevin Mills. Council can approve the ten day posting on the November 15, 2021 council meeting, to fill the remainder of Andy Rodgers term until December 31, 2021. Council would approve that appointment at the December 6, 2021 meeting. Council can choose at the December meeting to fill the unexpired term with Kevin Mills, (who was elected to the open four year seat to begin January 6, 2021).

Am I stating this correctly? This is all due to Kevin Mills running for a four year open seat versus the two year unexpired term?
