RIVERSIDE CITY COUNTIL MEETING: Monday, April 17, 2023

The regular Riverside City Council meeting started at 6 pm in the Riverside City Council Chambers. Mayor Allen Schneider called the meeting to order with Edgar McGuire, Kevin Kiene, Lois Schneider, Kevin Mills, and Tom Sexton present.

Motion made by Sexton, second by Mills to approve agenda. Passed 5-0.

Motion made by Kiene, second by Sexton to approve consent agenda, including April 3rd, and 5th minutes, expenditures, and March Fire Department Report, with pulling Summit Fire payment from expenditures until after discussion. Passed 5-0.

Chad Ellis, Washington County Lieutenant, gave the monthly call report for Riverside.

McGuire moved, second by Schneider to open Public Hearing for rezoning Parcel# 04-09-400-026 and 04-09-401-001 on Hwy 22 west of Casey's at 6:05 p.m. Clerk received one call from Casey's Corporation. There were no other oral or written comments. McGuire moved to close Public Hearing at 6:06 p.m.

Dr. Adib Amini, with Purpose Associates, address City Council on the importance of doing a Facilities Study on water and wastewater plants.

Luis Ramirez, of PeopleService Inc., presented the monthly water and wastewater report including discussions on Flygt pump repairs at wastewater plant, and replacement of E&H Chlorine and PH Panel.

Mark Skinner, with Summit Fire, explained repair need on the backflow preventer at the wastewater plant.

Kiene moved, seconded by Schneider to pay Summit Fire invoices. Passed 5-0.

Brian Boelk, Axiom Consultants updated the city council on the 3rd Street project, Wastewater Treatment Plant, Water Treatment Plant, Railroad Park, Kirk birthplace ramp, and Kleopfer/Buckeye storm water drainage.

Kiene moved, second by McGuire to proceed with bid documents to repair Water Plant with arial stainless steel piping. Passed 5-0.

McGuire moved, second by Schneider to pass 1st reading of Ordinance #2023-33, for rezoning Parcel# 04-09-400-026 and 04-09-401-001 on Hwy 22. Passed 5-0.

Sexton moved, second by Kiene, to suspend the rules for the second and third reading and approve and adopt Ordinance #2023-33. Passed 5-0.

Motion by McGuire, second by Kiene to pass Resolution #2023-34, Approving pay request #9 to Streb Construction for the 3rd Street Project in the amount of \$143,255.31. Passed 5-0.

Sexton moved, second by McGuire to pass Resolution #2023-35, Approving estimate for repairs to Flygt Pump 3153 at the wastewater plant in the amount of \$9351.85. Passed 5-0.

Kiene moved, second by Sexton, to table resolution for E&H Chlorine and PH Panel for next agenda. Passed 5-0.

McGuire moved, second by Schneider, to pass Resolution #2023-36, Approving proposal for backflow preventer repair at the wastewater plant from Summit Fire in the amount of \$4199.33. Passed 5-0.

Motion by Sexton, second by Kiene, to pass Resolution #2023-37, waiving the right to review plat for Linda Chapman located within the 2-mile radius of the City of Riverside. Passed 5-0.

McGuire moved, second by Schneider to allowing closing of a portion of River Street on May 5th and 6th for La Chiva Loka's outdoor concert event. Passed 5-0.

Council reviewed March Utility reports, and financials.

Motion by McGuire, second by Schneider to adjourn at 8:43 p.m. Motion carried 5-0.
